RCOM Bags ₹1,400-cr HDFC Bank's Data Centre Deal

NEW DELHI Anil Ambani-owned RCOM has clinched a ₹1,400-crore deal with Indian banking major HDFC Bank to build and maintain a data centre, a senior executive of the company said. According to the deal that spans over a period of 15 years, RCOM will build a new facility in over 3.5 lakh sq ft in Mumbai and maintain a data centre that will house computing power equipment. The first phase of the project will be completed within 12 months and data centre will be set up within 24 months. "This is the single-largest deal of this size in the sector so far — we've been competing for this over the last 10-11 months," Reliance Globalcom president and CEO Punit Garg said in an interaction with ET.
